**Subject:** Blanket Dispensation- security

The General Governor's Office has been informed that many State's State of Emergency Orders have shut down Lodges completely. Many of these Lodges have on-site security systems that allow for off-site access. Presently, the General Governor's Office has prohibited off-site access, due to instances of abuse of the technology.

For those Lodges who are able to take advantage of off-site access to Lodge security systems, the General Governor's Office offers a blanket dispensation to Administrators ONLY to utilize such off-site access.

We believe this blanket dispensation will affect a large number of Lodges, so feel free to publish the directive as appropriate, ie via an Official Communication. And, please note, the dispensation will only be available while the Lodges are closed and under the current State of Emergency.
