## Governor's Corner



Hey 73, often times you hear us talk about Moosehaven. I believe most of you know it's a retirement community situated on 63 acres next to the St John's River south of Jacksonville, Fl. This was not always the case. Originally Moose seniors resided at Mooseheart, the child city. As you might guess, housing seniors and children at the same complex was not the best scenario. In 1918 Director General James J Davis proposed finding a new home for Moosehaven. Sometime there after Supreme Secretary Rodney H. Brandon purchased the historic four story Hotel Marion, it's eight acres and named it Moosehaven. It was dedicated on October 3, 1922. The first 20 residents arrived in November and six months later that number grew to 50. By 1926 there were 144 residents. Initially Moosehaven was known as the "City of Endeavor". They performed their own work and operated a successful dairy and farm. Currently there are 306 residents living there. See ya around the lodge, Tom Weaver
