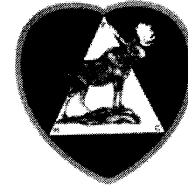

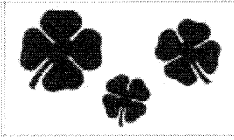

## PLAYERS NEEDED

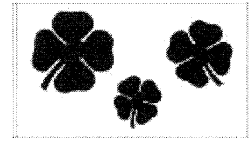
We are looking to see if we have enough
