## One Lucky Cat

On a cold snowy 11° Sunday with wind chills below zero, a plow crew was taking care of the ice and snow on our lodges parking lot when one of the crew members heard a tiny meow near the dumpster right behind the lodge. He asked another crew member if he had heard what he thought was a kitten. They both walked towards the sound and found a soaking wet little dark gray ball of fur no more than seven or eight weeks old shivering in a pile of snow. But there was a problem. The kitten was hurt and badly burnt on the right side of it's body, little ear, and the poor thing had no whiskers on the right side of it's face. The tiny kitten was in distress and pretty close to death.

The second crew member, Travis, picked up the kitten with tears in his eyes and carried it to his warm truck. He wrapped the kitten up in a spare hoodie and laid it near the trucks blasting heater and went back to finish cleaning the snow from the remaining parts of the parking lot as fast as he could.

Upset, Travis took the kitten home and found out the extent of it's injuries. He gave the kitten a warm bath to bring up it's body temperature that was so low. He carefully scrubbed off the burnt hair on it's body, ear and face. The kitten's ear had been burnt a quarter of an inch down from the tip. The kitten was in a lot of pain and stress at this point.

After the bath Travis rubbed the kitten dry and put burn cream on

it's ear. He gave the poor kitten some food and tried to get it to drink some water with a medicine dropper. The kitten didn't eat much but it was encouraging that it had tried to eat at all.

Travis held the tiny kitten a lot that first night close to his body to keep it warm not knowing if the kitten would make it through that first night at all.

How could this have happened to this vulnerable little ball of fur? Could someone have tried to set the poor thing on fire? Who would do such a thing? Could the kitten have climbed up into an engine trying to find a warm place as several days had gone by with -8° wind chill and had been burned by the exhaust pipe or the engine block? Travis was pretty sure the kitten had climbed up into the engine of a vehicle.

little more. Travis took great pains to make sure this little kitten was going to make it and make it it has.

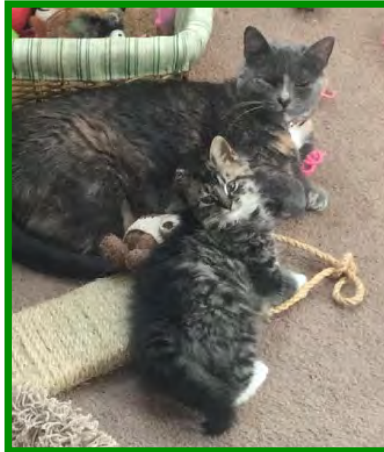

Also, a thank you to our 50/50 raffle winner Kelly who donated a portion of her winnings back.

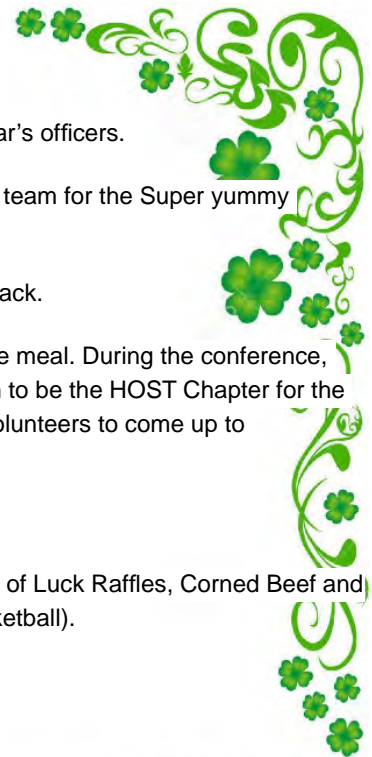
