WHAT MEMORIAL DAY REALLY MEANS



All too often around Memorial Day we tend to forget exactly why the holiday was created: to honor those American men and women who died during combat. The holiday, instituted in 1866 in the wake of the Civil War, was first known as Decoration Day. It was set aside to remember both Union and Confederate soldiers alike.

More Americans were lost during the Civil War (620,000) than died in both World Wars combined (521,000). Factor in the differences in population and you can imagine how hard of a hit the war between the north and south was on the country itself.


By the 1880's, the holiday came to be known officially as Memorial Day. A federal mandate in 1971 set the observance on the last Monday of May. This ensured long weekends for those of us lucky to have the day off the grill, travel, visit with friends and family, and do whatever else we want on Memorial Day.

It is also the beginning of the summer season, when the pools officially open and one week left of school for our youngsters. My hope is that, as parents, we tell our children what the holiday really honors.
