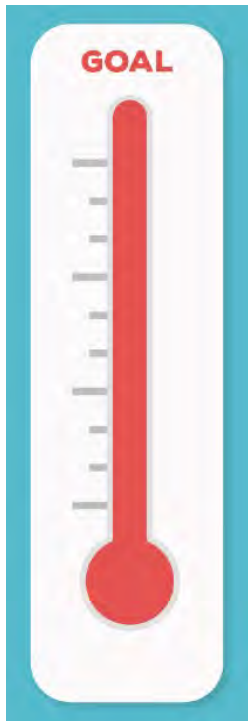

JUNE ANNOUNCEMENTS



PLEASE . . . DO NOT USE THE BACK ENTRANCE

Under NO circumstances should any member be using the back exit of the lodge to enter or leave. This is absolutely forbidden. This should only be used by employees of the lodge for trash disposal and for deliveries to the lodge.

This could jeopardize not only the employees, but it can also jeopardize our liquor license. This exit can only be used by lodge members if they have volunteered their services in the Social Quarters or if there is an emergency of any kind. You will get a warning from an Officer. An Employee of the Lodge can also file a complaint with the Officers and the Administrator. There could be consequences of this action.

So please, DO NOT use the back entrance.

ACTIVE MILITARY/ FIRST RESPONDERS MILITARY MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

From January 1, 2017 - December 31, 2017, Moose International will waive all fees and dues for a new or re-enrolled member of the military (active) and first responders. This group would be excellent candidates for advancement to higher degrees, including the Moose Legion. Active Duty Military includes: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, National Guard, Active Reservist, and Border Patrol. First Responders include: Law Enforcement, Firefighters (full time and volunteer), Paramedics, Emergency Medical Technicians. Not included at this time are: Veterans, Doctors, Nurses, National Guard, and Moose Multi-Members

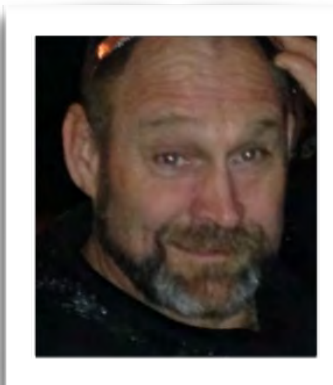
