## OHIO STATE FOOTBALL IS BACK!



On Thursday, August 31st, the Buckeyes take on Indiana at 8:00 PM in Prime Time. This will be the first time in 41 years that the season will start out with a conference game. It's only the seventh time Ohio State is starting the season not on a Saturday and only the third time they have started on a Thursday. The Buckeyes haven't played a conference team to start the season since beating Michigan State 49-21 in 1976.

ESPN is predicting 95.7% chance that the Buckeyes will beat Indiana. Not real good odds for the Hoosiers The Buckeyes are 12-0 when starting a season against a Big Ten team.

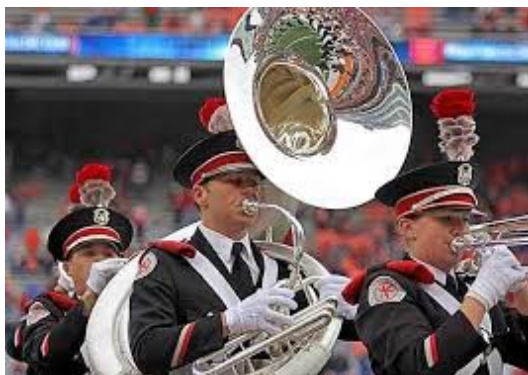
