SUPREME GOVERNOR TO VISIT

Worthington Moose Loge 1427 has been selected to host Rodney A. Hammond, Supreme Governor of the Loyal Order of Moose, at an enrollment of new members in his honor scheduled for 6:00 on Thursday, September 26, 2019. Brother Hammond rose to become the Moose Fraternity's Chief Presiding Officer on July 1, 2019, elected by vote of Supreme Lodge delegates to a one-year term, at the Fraternity's 131st International Convention in Las Vegas, NV.



Rodney had served as Supreme Jr. Governor since July 2018, elected to that post at the 130th International Convention in New Orleans, LA. Rodney has served on the Supreme Council, the Fraternity's corporate Board of Directors, since 2011. In addition, Rodney served on the Moosehaven Board of Directors for one year and also retired from the Moose International Membership Department in 2010, after serving as Regional Manager for Florida and Bermuda for over 10 years.

Rodney joined Kissimmee, FL Lodge 2056 as a charter member in 1978 and served as Administrator for 20 years, helping it to become one of the Fraternity's leading lodges. He is a Life Member there and received Honorary Past Governor distinction in 1989.

Rodney is also a Life Member of Indian River (FL) Moose Legion 178 and served as Secretary from 1993 to 1995. He served the Florida Bermuda Moose Association in numerous capacities and was conferred as Past President in 2001. He also served as Deputy Supreme Governor representing the Florida Bermuda Moose Association in 1996-1997.

A member of the 450 Division of the Moose 25 Club, Rodney earned the Moose Legion Elite Member Ring by sponsoring over 150 members into the Degree of Service. He received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1983 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1991.

He resides in Kissimmee, FL where he spends time with his family of two sons, five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

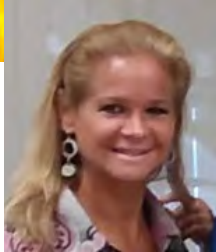
