10 O'Clock Liquor Sales Stop

Due to Governor DeWines executive order as of July 31, 2020, all liquor sales (last call) will be at 10:00 pm. The executive order as of now has no expiration date.

Under the rule, all Ohio establishments serving liquor must stop sales by 10:00 pm. Members will have until 11:00 pm to a finish their drinks. Only food can be served until closing.

We will let all our members know what the status of this rule is when there are changes made by the Governor or any executive entity that can make these rulings.
