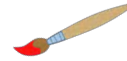
The LOOM \$500 Richard Fowler Memorial Scholarship drawing will be held Friday, August 11 (deadline to submit 8/4/17).

CRAFT NIGHT

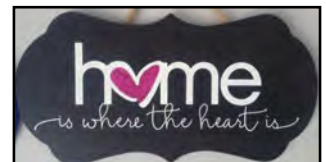
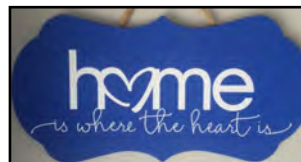


Want to spend some time with friends and have the chance to make new friends, too? Come and join us for a craft night on **Monday, May 8th** at 6:30. Cost is only \$25.
