Its scholarship time again. If you are the parent or grandparent of a high

school junior in the graduating class of 2020, applications are posted on the bulletin board in the social quarters at the west end of the bar. Take one, read the requirements, fill it out completely and bring it back to the Lodge Administrator (that's me). We also have scholarships available from our lodge. When you fill out an application for Moose International and return it to me, that same form will be used to apply for the local scholarship. If your student meets the requirements of Moose International, they will also qualify for the local scholarship entry. The only difference is that, to qualify for the local scholarship, the student applicant must attend high school in Defiance, Putnam, Paulding, Henry, Fulton or Williams County. Applications must be returned to me before June 30th, 2019.

- Moose International Heart of the Community Scholarship forms are posted on the bulletin board at the west end of the bar. For High School Graduating Class of 2020 Ohio high school juniors only, the scholarship is available to children or grandchildren of Defiance Moose members and is worth up to \$5000. Submission of the Heart of the Community Scholarship form also qualifies the student for scholarships up to a total of \$2500 from Defiance Lodge 2094, however only students from high schools in Defiance, Putnam, Paulding, Williams, Fulton, or Henry Counties. If you have questions, speak to the Lodge Administrator.
- Election of Moose Lodge Officers for the 2019-20 lodge year will be held on April 1st. Nominating Committee meetings will be held in February and March. Women's nominations are currently in progress. If you are interested in running for an office, speak to a current Chapter or Lodge Officer. Notices and additional information are posted on the bulletin boards in the lobby and on the WOTM board near the kitchen.
- Please do not block the entrance while smoking, and dispose of your cigarette butts in the appropriate receptacles. Smoking is only permitted in the fenced area around the smoke shed, not in the area just outside of the entrance doors.
