Congratulations to 2019 high school graduates Melissa Kings, Kerri Shannon, Hannah Horn and Sydney Grieser, who were awarded \$1000 scholarships from our lodge.

They also qualify for additional scholarships of up to \$500 per year for college years two through four. Keri and Sydney were also each awarded \$1000 as Moose International Heart of the Community Scholarship winners.

Remember, if you wish to use the lodge dance hall for a private gathering, a deposit and approval by the House Committee will be required. A complete set of rules is posted throughout the social quarters. There is still no charge to use the hall, since the deposit is fully refundable, but please fill out the form well in advance of your event, allowing enough time to be reviewed at a House Committee meeting, held every second and fourth Monday of the month.

I hope you like the most recent improvements in our social quarters. We've replaced the ceiling and overhead lighting with new grids and tile and LED light panels. We've also installed new carpet and replaced the anti-fatigue mat behind the bar. In addition, we relocated our Ritual star in the dance hall and added lighting to our 9 o'clock Prayer wall hangings. We've had many compliments from our members regarding the renewal of the prayer on Saturday evenings; especially positive comments about the participation

in the ceremony by so many different members. My hat is off to Jr. Past Governor, Larry "Sparky" McGuire for initiating the reestablishment of such an important Moose tradition. Sparky is also our leader and host of Orientation. Finally, I ask you all to be proud to show your Moose membership card whenever you are asked to present it by our bar staff. Most servers work primarily on either the day or night shift, so they might not recognize you when they fill in on another shift. We must always be prepared to show that we are paid-up members of the Moose to keep our private, not-for-profit status with the IRS and Ohio Liquor Control Board.
