Straight from the **ADMIN'**

- Park reservations are in full-swing. Here's a reminder of our policy for using the Park and Dance Hall: Park use is on a "first-come-first-served" basis, and we're sorry, but you can no longer reserve the dance hall to use in case of wet grounds or if rain makes the park area unsuitable. The dance hall may only be used by special request on Sundays for small family-event gatherings of less than 50 people, such as birthday parties for toddlers and preschoolers, or for baby showers. The hall is also available for small meetings on weekdays too. There is no charge to use either facility, but, to reserve the dance hall, you must make a \$200-fully refundable security deposit. Please remember that you must leave the park or the dance hall the way you found it. Your trash should be deposited in the large dumpster behind the lodge building. Finally, you must get approval from the Administrator to use either facility. Anytime the park is not in use, you are also invited to use the kids' playsets. The small gate by the shed is always unlocked.

- Big thank-you to Mary Jo Brown, who donated two American Flags and an Ohio Flag for our exterior flag poles.

- This year we will have two music in the park events! On Friday, July 12th, three of your favorite country music bands will take the stage at

the Mooseberry Jam. The bands are not officially set as of press time. The beneficiary and co-host of the Mooseberry Jam is Conquer Childhood Cancer Now. They will man the gates and provide food and soft drinks. We will need Moose volunteers for other responsibilities including set-up and tear-down. Please let me know that you are available and I'll find a spot for you. The original Party in the Park rock dance/concert is set for Friday, August 9th, with Fort Defiance Humane Society again as co-host and beneficiary. They have some exiting plans to bring in food vendors and the music line-up is phenomenal. Wally and The Beavs will team up with Brother Believe Me to bring you, what I call, "The Best of the Fest." Both bands have been favorites over the years at the Defiance Rib Fest. However, they've never performed together at the same fest.
