STRAIGHT FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

One of the perks of membership in our Lodge is the opportunity to use our wonderful park and, on Sundays, our banquet room for family events at no charge. I do want to remind you that you must speak to me to reserve your date. The only requirements are that you leave the park or the hall the way you found it. That means sweeping up any spilled foods on the floors of the hall or shelter houses and placing your bagged garbage in the large garbage bin behind the lodge building. Remember, the smaller bin is for cardboard only. If you drop garbage in that bin, we will be charged \$25 by Werlor. If you reserve a date and have a need to cancel your event, please be courteous to your fellow members and let me know of the cancellation ASAP so we can free up the date for others who may wish to use our facilities. I also want to remind you of our policy for the use of the banquet room for funeral lunches and the criteria for having food donated for the lunch. The Women of the Moose will cater a funeral luncheon for a deceased member or a living member's spouse or child (under the age of 21) at no cost to the family. Aunts, uncles, children over 20 years of age, brothers and sisters who were not themselves members of our Lodge or Chapter are ineligible. However, you may make special arrangements for the use of the banquet room at no cost, with the understanding that no food will be provided by the Moose volunteers. Speak to me or Yvonne Wilcox to make arrangements.

FYI, I offer some rules and guidelines for the social quarters (as dictated by the Ohio Moose State Association):

• A qualified guest may be defined as follows:

- An active Lodge or Chapter member's spouse may be admitted as a qualified guest into a Social Quarters of a lodge as many times as they'd like, unless the spouse's membership is in expired status.
- Anyone, age 21, or older, may visit the lodge twice; then either join, or not come back.
- Any active member's children (or other immediate family) under the age of 21 may visit the Lodge as many times as they'd like until they reach the age of 21.
- All guests and the introducing member shall enroll their names in the lodge guest register.

- Family members, friends or unmarried members and prospective members MUST leave when the member leaves.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests. A member may be dropped from the rolls for failure to pay restitution for property damaged or removed by the member of his guest.
- No person(s) of vicious or immoral reputation, or in a state of intoxication shall be admitted or allowed to remain in the social quarters. The bartender is authorized to refuse service to anyone in a state of intoxication. The House Committee may prevent admission of any undesirable pending a hearing.

A complete list of House Rules can be found on the bulletin board at the west end of the bar.

Finally, I want to remind you to occasionally review the items posted on the bulletin boards throughout the social quarters. Moose International is asking all members who are veterans of the United States Military to contact them so we may recognize your service to our country through the Moose Valued Veterans program. Upon your enrollment as a valued veteran, you will receive a new membership card that acknowledges your service, and, as the program progresses, you will receive useful information. Also, the First Responder new-member promotion has been extended until the end of the year. If you know a first responder—active military, EMT, police, firefighter—who is not yet a member, sign him or her up for membership. For first responders, the \$20 application fee and first year dues are waived.
