- NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING**

In accordance with the requirements of the General Laws of the Supreme Lodge of the Loyal Order of Moose, you are hereby notified that a special membership meeting of Defiance Lodge No. 2094 will be held at 7:15 P.M. on September 21, 2020 at the lodge home. The business to be considered and voted on shall be as follows:

Replace 49,600 square feet of the parking lot with 2" base course asphalt and 1.5" Type I surface course asphalt, removal of existing 3.5" asphalt, and striping of finished surface that will likely exceed the expenditure of \$5000.00 from our general fund.

Construction of a 10' X 12' smoking shelter, 20' X 32' and 14' X 44' concrete patios with 6' high aluminum fencing around the perimeters that will likely exceed the expenditure of \$5000.00 from our general fund.
