STRAIGHT FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

Attention parents or grandparents of students in their junior year of high school. Beginning in November, I will post, on the social quarters bulletin boards, information and applications for the Moose International Scholarship program. The R. Robert Dale Scholarship is now the Moose "Heart of the Community" Scholarship, and there are some changes you will want to take note of. Space doesn't permit to put all of the information in our newsletter, so please take a copy from the bulletin board or access the information at the Ohio State Moose Association or Moose International web sites. Our local scholarship offering will likely follow the same guidelines. The Heart of the Community application will also serve as the Lodge application. I will make a copy of it and place it in our local file for consideration. Both scholarships are for \$1000. Your student may also qualify for an additional 3-year renewal for up to \$500 per year.

Here's a reminder from last year. ... We are happy to cash your checks in the social quarters, but occasionally mistakes happen and we receive notification a bank that insufficient funds were in your account and the check is returned. In case that happens, you know it before we do. If you call me or Stacy immediately and let us know when you will be in to cover the debt, you will only be charged the \$15 NSF fee that the bank charges along with the amount written on the check. If you don't contact us, you will be charged \$50 for EACH check that is returned. A certified letter will be sent to you demanding full payment within 10 days. If you fail to respond in that time, the bad check(s) will be turned over to the police department and you will be prosecuted.

And another reminder: You are always welcome to reserve and use—at no cost—our extra tables and chairs that we store in the shed. However, you must make arrangements to pick them up and return them when two bartenders are scheduled so that one can accompany you to unlock the shed and take inventory, while the other remains to serve our other members. To reserve tables or chairs, speak with a bartender. To reserve the use of the park or of the hall (Sunday's only on the hall) you must speak with me.

Finally... WE NOW HAVE KENO! And, for your convenience, we also have Ohio video game machines and an Instant Scratch-off Ticket Dispenser in the lounge. Now there truly is no reason to sit at home. Instead, Do the Moose!
