For our 3rd Saturday entertainment should have been the A Mix Band, but unfortunately they were unable to perform due to one of the band members contracting COVID-19.

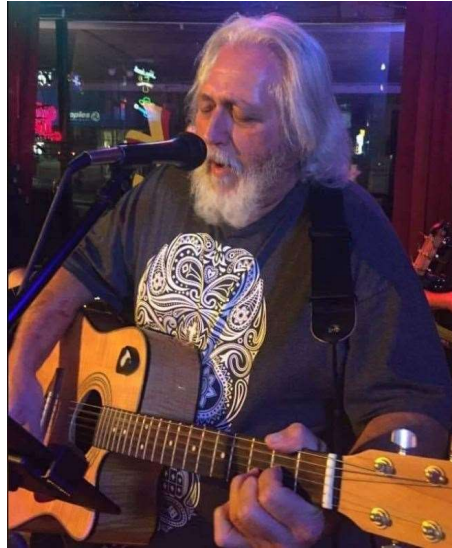


Their place was taken by Eric Sanson who did double duty this month.
